DIRECTIONS From the north or south: I-35 to Exit 111 (Hwy 30), west on Hwy 30 to Exit 146 (University Ave), north on University to Lincoln Way, west on Lincoln Way to Wallace Road and north on Wallace to the entrance to the parking lot. Signs will be posted.

From the east or west: Hwy 30 to Exit 146 (Elwood Drive), north on University to Lincoln Way, west on Lincoln Way to Wallace Road and north on Wallace to the entrance to the parking lot. Signs will be posted.

Prizes and Awards Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs in each height division in each class. Each team finishing a title will receive a "new title" rosette. The club reserves the right to substitute prizes of greater or equal value. All prizes must be claimed the day of show, none will be mailed.

Class Information: Standard Agility Classes

Novice Agility Class: The Novice Agility Class is divided into Division A for dogs which have never acquired an agility degree from any organization, Division B for dogs that have acquired any agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title in any organization and agility judges. **Open Agility Class:** Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility (NA) title or Open Agility (OA) title but which have not acquired the Agility Excellent (AX) title. **Excellent Agility Class:** The Excellent Agility Class is divided into Division A for dogs that have acquired the Open Agility title but have not acquired the Agility Excellent title, and Division B for dogs that have acquired the AX or MX titles. All MX legs must be earned from the B Division.

Class Information: Jumpers With Weaves (JWW)

As of Jan 1, 1999, any dog that has not obtained a qualifying score in the Open or Excellent level in JWW must enter the Novice JWW class. **Novice JWW:** The Novice JWW is divided into Division A for persons & dogs that have never acquired an agility title from any organization, and Division B for dogs that have acquired any agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title in any organization, and agility judges. **Open JWW:** Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice JWW (NAJ) or Open JWW (OAJ) title, but have not acquired the Excellent JWW (AXJ) title. **Excellent JWW:** The Excellent JWW class is divided into Division A for dogs that have acquired the OAJ title, but have not acquired the AXJ title, and Division B is for dogs that have acquired the AXJ or MXJ titles. All MXJ legs must be earned from the B division.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Exhibitors must compete at the level for which they are currently eligible.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

ARBITRATION: The Cyclone Country Kennel Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

All obstacles will conform to current requirements of the Agility Regulations.
All jumps will be displaceable.

Site Information This trial will be held at an outdoor sports complex on grass. This complex is used by Iowa State University as well as Iowa Games soccer competition. Please be as conscientious as possible and help The Cyclone Country Kennel Club of Ames protect their trial site. Exhibitors are expected to pick up after their dogs. Exhibitors observed not picking up after their dogs will be excused from the trial weekend and no moneys refunded. In addition, exhibitors may be subject to disciplinary action by the CCKC Trial Committee for any reported damages on show grounds and at area motels.

There is plenty of space for tents, crating & seating. No overnight camping or parking will be allowed. Tents may be left overnight. Park in designated areas only. The trial site is a NO SMOKING area per Iowa law – smoking is not allowed on the grounds.

Delicious, home made food will be available on site for lunch and snacks.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & WARM-UPS There will be no obstacle familiarization period prior to the start of Novice judging

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

The Regulations for Agility Trials are available from the AKC., 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100 , Raleigh , NC 27617 or online at akc.org.

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of judging. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing. The judge's briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for all exhibitors.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.**
- * The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when it is to be judged.**
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded for bitches in season.**
- * There will be a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks.**
- * It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.**
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.**
